Allison, author and executive, presents his leadership principles for individual happiness and success,

which also apply to organizations and society. His concept of happiness follows Aristotle's notion of

happiness or a life well lived. The author explains that happiness must be earned and is achieved by

setting goals and accomplishing them, and states, "Most failures of leadership are failures of self-

leadership." Stressing "leadership matters," he devotes most of the book to his leadership process in

which each of the following elements must be integrated with the others: a vision of what the organization

can be; communicate a purpose/mission statement that defines the vision; develop strategies to accomplish

the purpose; coach team/organization to successfully carry out the strategies as well as establish operating

values for them to follow. Believing "ideas matter," Allison describes the classical liberal/libertarian

leadership model: "The vision is a free and prosperous society based on the principles of individual

liberty, free markets, limited government, and peace." He concludes, "Freedom and liberty are essential

for happiness."
