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## Health Care Reform: Bookeristas Comment

Yes, health care continues to be the numero uno issue among America's black center-right. Here are the key themes being addressed by bookeristas:



### "Join The Resistance!"

**Ken Blackwell, a conservative Republican commentator, opines:** "Serfs were peasants tied to the land in Old Russia. When issues like abortion mandates-in-health-care and forced end-of-life-decision-making are raised, they have a strong resonance with millions of Democrats, Republicans, *and* Independents. After all, everyone has a life. If you'd like to make the key decisions about yours without government mandates, join the resistance."
