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Ruling in Virginia's Challenge to Obamacare Individual Mandate Expected Today

A ruling in Virginia's constitutional challenge to Obamacare's individual mandate is expected later today. The Competitive Enterprise Institute joined in an <u>amicus brief</u>^[1] filed in support of Virginia's lawsuit by the Cato Institute and constitutional law professor Randy Barnett. Earlier, I <u>discussed</u> ^[2] why the health care law's individual mandate (requirement that individuals buy health insurance) exceeded Congress's power under the Interstate Commerce Clause. You can find that discussion at <u>this link</u> ^[2]. (I was a lawyer in the last Supreme Court case that struck down a federal law under the Commerce Clause, *United States v. Morrison*, 529 U.S. 598 (2000).)

The judge in the Virginia case, U.S. District Judge Henry Hudson, earlier rejected the government's motion to dismiss Virginia's lawsuit at a preliminary phase (a Rule 12(b)(6) motion to dismiss).

Update: Judge Hudson <u>rules against the Obama administration</u> ^[3], finding that the individual mandate is unconstitutional.

Earlier, I discussed some of the bad effects of Obamacare on <u>patients</u>^[4], <u>employers</u>^[5], <u>consumers</u>^[6], and the insurance market ^[7].
