Study Shows Louisiana Voucher Cuts Are Penny Wise, Pound Foolish

ICYMI, Cory DeAngelis of the University of Arkansas wrote a <u>blog post</u> at *Education Next* today summarizing the results of <u>a study</u> he conducted with Julie Trivitt on the fiscal effects of the <u>Louisiana Scholarship Program</u> (LSP). The post is worth reading in full, but the main point is this: their study found that the LSP saves taxpayers money.

Governor John Bel Edwards recently cut the voucher program, supposedly in order to save money. However, the new study finds that the cuts actually *increase* state expenditures. DeAngelis concludes that if Louisianan officials wish to save money, instead of cutting it, they should expand it.
