Health care bill Senate/House comparison

Interesting, upon reading the document comparing the 2 bills (<http://www.speaker.gov/pdf/HScomparison.pdf>) from Jamie's link, there are no maximum annual premiums stated for households making over 400% of the

federal poverty level. For those in the 300-400% range House bill is capped at 12% of income for premiums. Senate bill at 9.8%. Guess they want to stick it to that group when the final bill is written. For those of you wondering if it affects you, well, if you are a 2 person household and make over \$29,140 it affects you. If a 3 person household and make over \$54,930 it affects you. If 4 people and over \$88,200 it affects you. If 5 people and over \$103,160 it affects you. Heck, just figure it at 10%. So, a family of four will pay AT LEAST \$8,820 in premiums. Then, the max out of pocket expense is another \$8,200 to \$10,000 for the family, depending on the bill. Folks, this will destroy the economy. Of course, the Democrats must destroy it in order to control it.
