RICHMOND

Virginia officials are planning for the creation of a state health insurance exchange to comply with the federal health care act, even as Gov. Bob McDonnell supports a state legal challenge that could overturn the law.

A meeting Tuesday of the Joint Commission on Health Care included an update on the process of setting up an exchange. The panel also heard from a think tank scholar who spoke against that

Health insurance exchanges are marketplaces through which individuals without insurance and small businesses without group insurance plans can buy coverage. Those who meet income eligibility guidelines could receive subsidies.

Dr. Bill Hazel Jr., Virginia's secretary of Health and

Human Resources, said it's prudent to be prepared, given the uncertain outcome of the lawsuits over the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act, a signature policy initiative of President Barack Obama.

Virginia Attorney General Ken Cuccinelli is among those involved in litigation over the health care law; he has argued that Congress exceeded its authority by requiring the uninsured to obtain coverage or face a tax penalty. A ruling on his lawsuit is pending in federal appellate court.

Michael Cannon, director of health policy studies for the libertarian Cato Institute, cited suits such as Cuccinelli's in urging Virginia leaders not to proceed with developing an exchange. He argued that doing so gives a hint of legitimacy to a law whose constitutionality is in question.

"Creating an exchange does not make the best of a bad situation," Cannon said. "It makes the bad situation. The most responsible course for Virginia is to refuse to create an exchange."

States were given the option to establish their own exchange or adopt a federal model. Virginia opted to plan for its own exchange, a process provided for in legislation approved this year.

Because state exchanges must be in place by Jan. 1, 2014, Virginia is working under the expectation that it needs to have a working framework in place by 2013, Hazel said.

That means the General Assembly may have to address the issue next year after a state health reform advisory council makes its recommendations to McDonnell and the legislature this fall.

There is little dispute the United States has health care challenges related to the cost and delivery of services, Hazel said. In Virginia, it is estimated that 1 million people lack health insurance.

Regardless of "whatever happens across the Potomac Ocean," Hazel told the commission, drawing


laughs, "we absolutely have health care issues in Virginia we must solve."


