

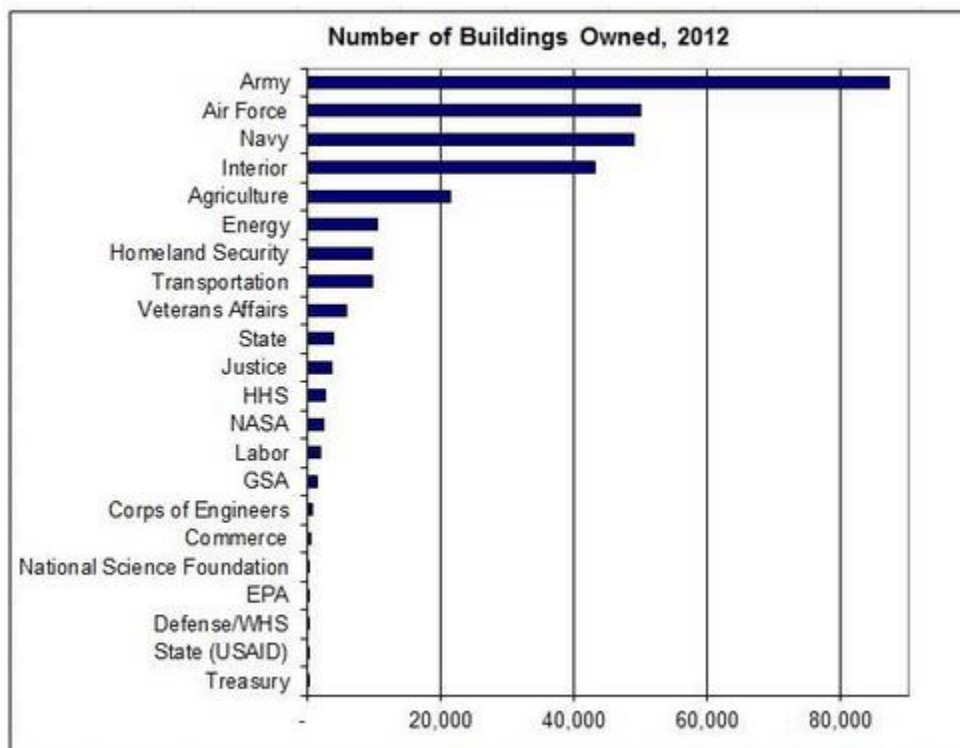

## Guess Which Departments And Agencies Own Most Of The Federal Government's 306,000 Buildings? [GRAPHIC]

The U.S. government owns, as of 2012, more than 300,000 buildings, the General Services Administration says.

The GSA, in a recent report, said that three branches of the military, the Army, Air Force and the Navy, own roughly half of the federal government's 306,000 buildings.
