An American Expert Claims that Iran Has Become a Nuclear Power IG News

Washington (Daily Pakistan Online) Richard W. Rahn, senior fellow at the Cato Institute and president of the Institute for Global Economic Growth, said Iran probably has five nuclear bombs and may have a dozen by May.

In his article written in the American news agency "Washington Times", Richard wrote that as early as last October, the intelligence services claimed that Iran had one week to build a bomb and six weeks. There may be enough weapons-grade enriched uranium for five nuclear bombs These estimates are more than three months old.

If Iran has a bomb, why isn't it mentioned in the press? Richard says the Iranians probably won't want to claim they have a nuclear bomb until they have a dozen or more working bombs in various locations.

Declaring one bomb would be foolish, he said, because the United States and Israel would go to great lengths to find and destroy it, but multiple bombs in multiple locations would make that "destruction" complicated, if not nearly impossible.

Richard says the Biden administration has a strong case for hiding or not disclosing the existence of Iran's bombs, given President Biden's repeated promises over the years that he would not allow the Iranians to possess nuclear weapons.

Barack Obama and Donald Trump made similar promises when they were president.

If the Biden administration acknowledges the presence of the Iranian bomb, the president will be under pressure to act.

According to Richard, the Israelis have also vowed not to allow Iran to have a bomb for the simple reason that if Iran has many nuclear bombs, it could mean the end of Israel.
