

FREEDOM OF FREE SPEECH IN THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA


Liberals Most Likely To Feel Comfortable Sharing Political Beliefs; Conservatives Most Likely to Self-Censor

Agree/Disagree: The political climate these days prevents me from saying things I believe because others might find them offensive.



The poll further states that 58% of Americans believe the political climate today prevents them from saying things they believe. 53% of Democrats do not feel the need to self-censor. 73% of Republicans say they keep some political beliefs to themselves.

HATE SPEECH IS MORALLY UNACCEPTABLE IN THE US



59 percent of Americans think people should be allowed to express unpopular opinions in public. While 79 percent think that it is morally unaccepted to deliver a hate speech. 6 in 10 Republicans agree with President Trump that the media are enemies of the American people.

POLITICAL CORRECTNESS AND INTERSECTIONALITY

61% of Democrats say it's hard for them to be friends with Trump voters. But the more Democrats alienate Trump voters, the more they're setting up Trump's re-election effort.
