Dissident Chinese Economist Allowed to Receive Friedman Prize

Economist <u>Mao Yushi</u> on Friday received the <u>Milton Friedman Prize for Advancing Liberty</u>, awarded biennially by the Cato Institute, after a tense several days during which his detention by Chinese authorities seemed imminent. "We're relieved that the Chinese government has kept its word," said Cato founder and president <u>Edward H. Crane</u>. "Given the current political environment in China, we were preparing an alternative program in case the event had to go forward without our honoree."
