

## Panic as rockets hit Russian embassy in Damascus

Russia's National Antiterrorism Committee said on October 11 that often "criminals" were actually found distributing heroin inside an house in american Moscow, exactly where safety and security work found and defused an "improvised intense device".

The Syrian civil war is now a proxy war between Russian Federation and the United States, with each side fueling the conflict with more firepower.

A US-led air coalition fighting IS in Syria has also targeted Al-Nusra on several occasions.

This summer, Defense Secretary Ash Carter admitted the US had only trained about 60 rebel fighters.

The low numbers are blamed on a strict vetting process that includes ensuring the fighters are committed to combat ISIS, as opposed to the Assad regime, and passing a counterintelligence screening.

"That was a complete and total failure for a plethora of reasons", said CNN senior global correspondent Arwa Damon, who has reported from Syria.

Of the 80 airstrikes the US believes the Russians have conducted, "only a fraction" are against ISIS targets, Warren said.

Moscow says it is targeting only banned terrorist groups in Syria, primarily Islamic State. "The Assad regime bears the greatest responsibility for the 250,000 deaths of the conflict and the millions of displaced people".

Jolani called on armed opposition groups to set aside their differences until both air wars had been defeated. As people started running away, another shell hit the area.

"Crushing blows are going to be carried out against this region", one flier states. "When you approach to the army's checkpoint walk in the open road and lift up this card or a white cloth".

Its only reliable naval port on the Mediterranean Sea is there - Tartus. The Syrian regime has purchased billions of dollars worth of Russian weapons.

Warren said the group's leader has been vetted by the USA and given "specific training" on a few specialized equipment.

Also Tuesday, rights group Amnesty worldwide accused Kurdish forces in north and northeast Syria of committing "war crimes" by forcibly displacing perceived IS supporters and demolishing their homes.

Brad Stapleton, a visiting research fellow at the Cato Institute, said more carnage will likely ensue.

The Observatory and Lebanon-based al-Mayadeen television station said the pro-government forces captured the southern part of the town on Monday.
