Wisconsin Forum to bring in streetcar foe

The [Wisconsin Forum](#), a little known group that promotes individual freedom and limited government, plans to bring in a prominent foe of Milwaukee's proposed [streetcar project](#).

The group has invited Randal O'Toole, a senior fellow at the [Cato](#) Institute, to speak at a March 6 meeting at the Milwaukee Athletic Club.

In a report written for the MacIver Institute for Public Policy, O'Toole has called the proposed \$64.6 million project a scam.

Ryan Law, president of the Wisconsin Forum advisory board, said the group brings in prominent speakers to talk about important public-policy matters.

This spring, the city plans to release the proposed route of the streetcar and hopes to begin construction of the streetcar guideway in spring 2014.
