Is Cnn A News Network

There is some debate over whether CNN is a **news network** or not. Some say that CNN is more of an entertainment network, while others believe that it is a reliable source for news. However, the majority of people seem to agree that CNN is a news network.

The primary goal of the network is to keep the public informed by providing them with constantly updated information on the most recent events. Since its inception on June 1, 1980, the network has expanded its reach to a number of cable and satellite television networks, 12 web sites, two private place-based networks, and two radio networks. CNN broke the news of the attacks on the World Trade Center towers on September 11, 2001, becoming the first media outlet to do so. CNN launched **CNN Exchange** and CNN iReport in 2006 as a response to the growth of social media and user-generated content. Since CNN's inception, it has been the subject of numerous controversies and allegations of bias. CNN is accused of liberal editorializing in its reporting. The media conglomerate has been accused by some critics of being pro-conservative.

According to Media Matters, there are hundreds of instances in which conservative editorials have been featured. **International journalists** have also criticized CNN for its coverage of the Iraq War. CNN was banned in Iran in January 2006 after reporting on the President of the Republic of Iran, Mahmoud Ahmadinejad. The ban was lifted a day later after CNN issued an official apology. The White House accused CNN in October 2006 of propagandizing Americans. According to CNN effect theories in political science and media studies, the development of CNN contributed significantly to states' foreign policy objectives. CNN International has a large number of foreign leaders' English-language news broadcasts.

These figures suggest that 24-hour news networks are useful and viable around the world. Policy-making has accelerated in the aftermath of the information revolution and the spread of **global mass media** via the Internet. Increased penetration and increased media accessibility may increase public transparency, but it can also cause diplomatic tensions to flare. Cnn: The Leading Source Of News And Information

CNN, which was founded in 1980, began broadcasting 24 hours a day, seven days a week. It was founded in 1998 as a joint venture by Ted Turner and Ross Perot, with a \$10 million initial investment. CNN transformed itself during the late 1990s with the launch of its news divisions, which included **international news**, business, legal, political, and science and technology news. CNN International (CNNi), an international news channel that is available 24 hours a day, was also launched. CNN employs over 1,000 people and has offices in over 40 countries as of 2019. The network has been honored with over 300 prestigious awards, including the Peabody Award,

the most prestigious honor in broadcasting. CNN is well-known for providing news and information, and it has been credited with changing perceptions about the world.
