

India votes: World's largest election gets under way

People <u>began voting</u> in the world's largest election Thursday, with 18 states and 2 union territories casting their ballots in the first phase of India's six-week-long polls.

Details: Nearly a billion people will vote in the general election, as Prime Minister Narendra Modi seeks a second term in office. The Indian-controlled areas of the disputed Kashmir region were among the first to vote. The Cato Institute's Shar Khan <u>noted</u> in an Axios article Modi was eyeing an electoral opportunity in escalating tensions with Pakistan in the region, with <u>reciprocal attacks</u> in February.
