Petersburg College assisting displaced ITT Tech

For the more than 500 students impacted by the closing of ITT Technical Institute in Arlington, TX, hope for successful completion of their studies and a smooth transition to the workforce is not lost, thanks to Tarrant County College.

SPC has a team of admissions, advising, and financial assistance staff members ready to assist ITT Tech students to enroll in classes as early as September 12 (SPC's Express Term) or October 10 (one of SPC's 8-week fall modules).

Note: SPC is waiving its \$40 application fee to students displaced by the ITT closure.

Some undergraduate degree programs at UNT are created to accept 45 or more transfer students from technical programs, the university said on Thursday.

"We support federal efforts to help students discharge their debt from fraudulent institutions like ITT Tech, and advocate for additional debt clinics to be made available in New Mexico to help students navigate their finances to achieve their educational goals".

Before ITT closed, it was also ordered to reach an Articulation Agreement with other schools which would, therefore, be more likely to accept credits already earned. Cato Institute Education Analyst Neal McCluskey said most of those students will pick up classes at community colleges.

OCC's outreach event is created to assist former ITT students with figuring out if any of the community college's academic programs fit their needs.
