National economic policy experts offer different answers at MSU Denver's Exploring Economic Freedom guest lecture series on Nov. 10

Mark Krikorian, executive director of the Center for Immigration Studies, will debate with Alex Nowrasteh, an immigration policy analyst at the CATO Institute's Center for Global Liberty and Prosperity at Metropolitan State University of Denver, on the ramifications of U.S. immigration policies. The debate will be moderated by KUSA-TV 9NEWS reporter and son of Costa Rican immigrants Jonathan Gonzalez, who earned an Emmy Award for his work on the migrant farmworker shortage at KBAK/KBFX-TV in Bakersfield, California.
