The New Report on Private Student Loans

The Department of Education has just released a report that blames private lenders for the woes that many students are facing. Neal McCluskey of the Cato Institute <u>writes here</u> that it's ironic, since the 800-pound gorilla that the report ignores is the enormous federal student-lending program.
