USHSR PUSHES BACK: The U.S. High-Speed Rail Authority is fighting back against some of the recent bad press on the state's \$68 billion plan. In an email to supporters, USHSR President and CEO Andy Kunz targeted the Reason Foundation, the Heritage Foundation and the Cato Institute, which he said "receive significant funding from oil and road interests who view high-speed rail as a threat to their profits."
