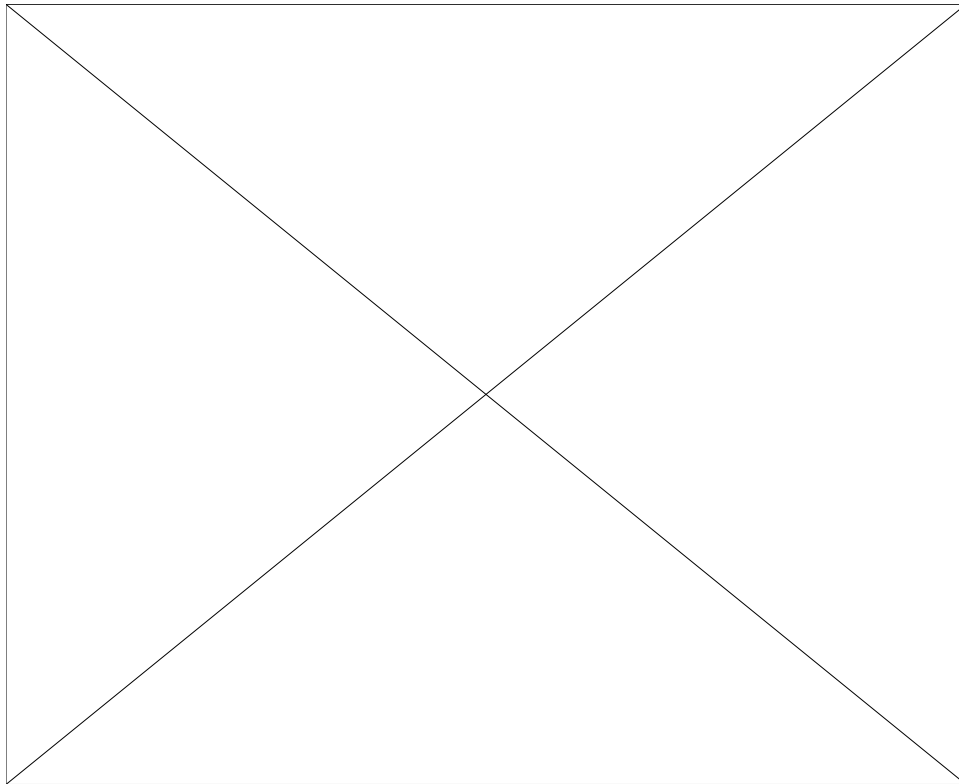


Cato: Five rules for going to war
