## Reactions to Court Ruling Striking Down Part of Obamacare in Virginia v. Sebelius

Yesterday, a federal judge in Richmond [struck down](#) <sup>[1]</sup> Obamacare's requirement that individuals buy health insurance. Cato Institute's Ilya Shapiro reacts to the decision [here in an article at CNN](#) <sup>[2]</sup>. Ilya was the principal author of an amicus brief filed on behalf of the Cato Institute and others in support of Virginia Attorney General Kenneth Cuccinelli's lawsuit against Obamacare.

The [Competitive Enterprise Institute](#) <sup>[3]</sup> and law professor Randy Barnett joined [that brief](#) <sup>[4]</sup>, which you can [find here](#) <sup>[5]</sup>. I am listed on the brief since I made a few suggestions that were incorporated into the brief based on my past experience in handling federalism cases (such as the Supreme Court's [Morrison decision](#) <sup>[6]</sup>). The brief was submitted to the court by the distinguished Richmond lawyer Patrick McSweeney, who has won landmark cases (such as a no-taxation-without-representation case in the Virginia Supreme Court called *Marshall v. Northern Virginia Regional Transportation Authority*, a case that I earlier [discussed at this link](#) <sup>[7]</sup>).

At Volokh Conspiracy, there are reactions to the decision from law professors [Jonathan Adler](#) <sup>[8]</sup> and [Ilya Somin](#) <sup>[9]</sup>. I earlier discussed the [constitutional issue in the case here](#) <sup>[10]</sup>, and more recently discussed the harm Obamacare inflicts on [medical innovation](#) <sup>[11]</sup>, [employers](#) <sup>[12]</sup>, [the public](#) <sup>[13]</sup> and [access to quality health insurance](#) <sup>[14]</sup>.
