"Newly released Census data reveals nearly 110 million Americans – more than one-third of the country – are receiving government assistance of some kind," according to a report written by Mike Emanuel and posted on FoxNews.com. "This includes welfare programs ranging from food stamps to subsidized housing to the program most commonly referred to as "welfare," Temporary Assistance for Needy Families.
