

Senate OKs bill to promote energy

The Senate voted 85 to 12 in favor of the Energy Policy Modernization Act, the first major energy bill to come to the floor since the Bush administration. The Senate vote brought Congress one step closer to embracing policies that say yes to energy, "he said. It requires the Secretary of Energy, Secretary of Agriculture, and the Administrator of the U.S. EPA to jointly ensure federal policy relating to forest bioenergy is consistent across all departments and agencies and that the full benefits of forest biomass for energy, conservation and responsible forest management are recognized.

After the vote, Sen. Maria Cantwell, D-Wash., champions wind power and conservation.

"At the beginning of a year ago, not only did we have these previous issues in which we saw the world differently, but we were going head-to-toe on the Keystone XL pipeline", said Cantwell.

Environmental policy analyst Peter Van Doren of the Cato Institute told The Christian Science Monitor by phone that the reason this bill had passed was less due to genuine goodwill than the success of each side's agenda.

The relatively short duration of the Senate bill - it would expire after about 18 months, at the end of fiscal 2017 - will give the Republicans who support shifting the FAA employees another opportunity to press for it in the near term. The House of Representatives passed a similar bill a year ago. "This <u>legislation</u> will help catalyze the fast-maturing domestic LNG industry".
