Recently the [Cato Institute](#) launched [Libertarianism.org](#), a site that is a “resource on the theory and history of liberty, broadly construed.”

In its introduction, the site explains the importance of liberty and what it means: “Liberty. Many people believe that liberty is the core political value of modern civilization itself, the one that gives substance and form to all the other values of social life. Libertarian scholars address hard problems and propose solutions that are both moral and realistic. Libertarian activists work to defend liberty from its many enemies and to advance liberty to those who have been excluded from its blessings. They seek to liberate individuals and bring about open, free, humane, and prosperous societies. The people of the world have waited long enough to be free.”
