

I haven't had time to see *Avatar* yet, but I read that the blockbuster is taking heat from folks on the Right, arguing that it is anti-American, anti-military and anti-corporate. But in the *Los Angeles Times* today, Cato Institute Executive VP

<u>David Boaz</u> ^[2] has a <u>different take</u> ^[3]. He argues that conservatives have missed the issue at its core:
