## Karzai, the Godfather of Afghanistan (16) the clash ...

Well we have finally: this summer has been eventful in Afghanistan, and the clash is (finally) arrived. Hamid Karzai between now very close to the Taliban, and American power that has had enough of his presence, and especially its inaction in addressing corruption in the country. This summer, the bridges were broken after recent tense negotiations and a video-conference between him and Barack Obama. The Americans seem to decide to drop Karzai, on behalf of the image he presents to the American people, he made clear, including John Kerry, special envoy of the U.S. Senate in a last-ditch attempt reconciliation. The question is how, now, Americans are resolved to get rid of Hamid Karzai or if they will dare to do, and by whom will it be replaced. The last time the United States had resolved to pass the one they had <a href="themselves set up">themselves set up</a>, it had ended in bloodshed: in Saigon was corrupt with the brothers Ngo Dinh Nhu and <a href="Ngo Dinh Diem">Ngo Dinh Diem</a>. And Found <a href="Dead">Dead"suicide"</a> November 2, 1963 at the bottom of a transport vehicle of the Vietnamese army. Elimination decided by ... John Fitgerald Kennedy then presented everywhere as <a href="champion of peace(1">champion of peace(1)</a>. But we're not 47 years ago, and it is unclear the same epilogue happen today ... though. That at least is what I propose to study in three successive episodes (and certainly others, to follow the events that rush there at great speed) ...



The case starts today in fact in March, to <u>leave the election</u> fraud that have been important (and one French representative denounced: the <u>General Morillon</u>, a delegate on site, as Chief Election Observation Mission of the European Union, which has put his foot in it without hesitation in speaking of "massive fraud". Two days later, Hamid Karzai told a group of MPs that if the foreign interference in his government continued, the Taliban would become a legitimate resistance - one that he may even join, according to several members present. "The little phrase Karzai seems to be lost in the media: none is the scandal created by the announcement. They were content to not listen.

On April 2, 2010, Hamid Karzai this time creates a stir in the U.S. press and media, during a speech he uses the word "invaders" about U.S. troops, a term previously used by Taliban. "L The idea that Ahmed Wali should be returned is generated by those who wish to leave Kandahar for the Taliban." Karzai is so furious and shows rather sharply: "My spokesman said yesterday that the names of some Afghans who cooperate with the international forces had been revealed in these documents," said Hamid Karzai, in Kabul yesterday. C is patently offensive and extremely irresponsible, because these people act legitimately or not providing information to NATO forces, they are lives. And these lives are now at risk. This is a extremely irresponsible act that I do can ignore, "he denounced. We must see the context in which these names are mentioned, and act accordingly. It is a very serious matter (which) we are worried about" says it everywhere. His anger, as one might think legitimate is actually fake: it is not the lives of informants who embarrassed him, but the revelations of Wikileaks from its own secret contacts with the Taliban, and the names of traffickers with whose family operates. "In a 2007 report, a senior official accused of corruption by senior government figures, note the Latest News from Alsace. (1) From a very good report on the death of Diem's brothers, told by General Dinh, deputy Minh. According to history, it is on the order of President Kennedy, for a few days before Henry Cabot Lodge, U.S. Ambassador in Saigon refused to meet with Diem to warn of the coup prepared by his generals led by Dương Văn Minh, who sent two of his officers, Captain Nguyen Van Nhung and Major Duong Nghia Hiếu to perform the task. Two "Dai Viet" as said Dinh (supporters of aboriginal Vietnam and the Emperor: two traditional nationalists, ie two right-wing extremists) ... This was one of the "Dai Viet" who hated both Nhun for use in the secret police to kill one of their friends or their parents. It was a combination Vietnamese-Laotian and Barjot who practiced full of bizarre tribal rituals such as drinking blood, and was known for killing a little too much. May Huu Xuan, the officer in charge was also another of those "Dai Viet". If you have a bunch of guys "Dai Viet" to escort their former enemies into a place of safety, you might as well sign a death warrant for the official convoy. This happened shortly after crossing the railroad: Nhung took out his bayonet and started to stab Nhu. Nhu had started calling his name and insult him in the fashion of the time before they embark on the M113. They shouted for more, but Nhung began to stab and locked up inside. He turned and fired at point blank in the head of Diem and Nhu turned to finish, ensuring that the brothers are themselves dying loved one another. However, knowing Nhu I do not think that would be discussed with Nhu Nhung and others ... he was always calm in decision-making and analysis of situations. With his hands tied and his brother at his side, he knew he n was not able to raise his voice, or any insult. Besides, I think it would not even bother to waste his breath talking to Nhung. Nevertheless, Nhung and others were on a mission of murder and not an escort, so I think he did it more calmly, more systemic, not just with rabies or spontaneity.

To read this excellent analysis by Malou Innocent and Ted Carpenter, analysts at the Cato Institute in Washington, DC: "As in the case of Diem, U.S. policymakers were initially full of praise for the place of Karzai. In 2002, The newly installed leader in Afghanistan was a guest of honor at his State of the Union, and in 2004, President George W. Bush spoke of Karzai as a man of "honor, courage and competence "and promised" unwavering commitment "to America to help his country succeed.

But as in the case of Diem also allegations of corruption and apparent contempt for democratic norms Karzai - and his growing unpopularity among his people - have reached the point that U.S. officials reacted angrily. In November 2009, Karl W. Eikenberry, U.S. ambassador to Kabul bluntly warned his superiors that Karzai is "not a suitable strategic partner."

There is little doubt that if America could find a replacement more credible, it would get rid of Karzai. But the lesson of experience with Diem probably induces caution. In 1963, the Kennedy administration gave its tacit approval to the South Vietnamese army for a coup against Diem. But the overthrow and murder of Diem did that make the already fragile U.S. mission in Vietnam even more untenable. U.S. officials fear a similar outcome is likely in Afghanistan if they encouraged the opponents of Karzai to overturn it.
