higher unemployment, lower wages and increased welfare spending are cited as reasons for this law.

These claims are largely bogus. A study by Walter Ewing of the Immigration Policy Center shows that if illegals were to suddenly disappear, crime in America would actually increase. Syndicated columnist, Stephen Chapman, notes that El Paso, the ultimate border city, is one of the safest in America.

Immigrant labor fills the demand for low-skilled jobs, as native-born Americans have become more skilled and educated(In the early 60s, almost half of native workers were high school dropouts-compared to only 7% today). The National Bureau of Economic Research found that illegals have only a "modest" effect on the wages of low-skilled natives and that they actually increase the real wages of everybody else. The Cato Institute reports that studies conducted by states like Texas and North Carolina, have found only a slight efect on state and local budgetswhich are more than offset by the taxes that illegals pay.


