

Cowering parents vs. a P.C. culture

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It's not a politically correct thing to say but a Christian blogger has spoken some truth to the culture.

In a post on The Daily Wire called "Dear Gender Non-Conforming Person, I Won't Let You Impose Your Confusion on My Child," writer Matt Walsh takes on a transgender activist who insists parents use their children's confusion at what is obviously a man in women's clothes as a teaching opportunity.

"I will not normalize your behavior to my kids," writes Walsh. "They naturally think it's silly. I will foster and nurture that reaction."

Christian apologist Alex McFarland of Truth for a New Generation agrees.

"We must insert sanity back into the equation and we must be willing to speak truth," he observes. "The politically correct Left, the social engineers, and the progressives have worked hard to silence people."

McFarland also points to a recent Cato Institute study that showed 71 percent of adults have opinions they're afraid to voice.

"Being frightened into silence," he says, "walking on social eggshells so that you don't speak moral truth – that's exactly what the progressives have wanted."

Walsh, a Catholic writer and speaker, is known for his provocative commentaries that often slam not just the culture but the Church for ignoring the ongoing culture wars when the Left is hard at work.

A March 6 commentary, for example, slams Christians who villify Hollywood but watch its shows and movies anyway.

In the commentary on transgenders, Walsh praises his wife for reacting to her daughter's reaction when they came across a man dressed as a woman in public.

"My wife was right to tell my daughter that the boy in a dress was a boy, and to say it right there, on the spot, in front of him," he writes. "She was not out to hurt his feelings."

The ongoing issue of transgenders is a current hot-button topic, especially since their suicide attempt rate hovers at a staggering 40 percent.

Walsh and others point out mental illness is clearly an issue, hence the alarmingly high suicide rate, but affirming LGBT activists claim discriminiation is to blame while the media often ignores the crucial statistic altogether.

McFarland says the pressure that's put on children is enormous, aided by a pop culture media, academia, and politicians. But parents must fight back on behalf of their families.

"We've got to divest ourselves of this politically correct delusion," he says, "if we're going to have the America we've enjoyed for more than two centuries."
