Latest News - U.S.: officials on the drucken rise

Dramatic increase in the income gap between beneficiaries and taxpayers, tax

(Ef-DS) The American Economic Research Bureau of Economic Analysis (BEA) publishes annual data on incomes of U.S. citizens. An analysis of data by employees of the Cato Institute has revealed that the U.S. net public profiteers live in rapidly increasing at the expense of the private sector, ie taxpayers.

Even at the turn of the millennium, the average annual salary of nearly two million U.S. federal employees, including all donations around 76,000 U.S. dollars, while a private sector-working taxpayers, on average, about 60 percent of them earned, namely \$ 46,000. Today,

ten years later, earned the average tax exploiters 123 000 U.S. dollar and this high level of co-financing income tax 61 000 victims of U.S. dollars, of which this is less than half.

U.S. officials in general earn not only a lot more money, but also live in greater safety: the risk of release to be, is with them three times lower than those of their breadwinners. Consequently, there are about eight times the working end from the private sector, the change in the civil service, as civil servants who go the opposite way.
