Chairman of the Board of the Cato Institute Robert Levy gave another presentation for local 9-12ers today. This speech was presented at Hendersonville High School. Levy repeated many of the jokes shared with 9-12ers at Haywood Community College August 22. In Haywood County, Levy provided an overview of his book, *The Dirty Dozen*; in Hendersonville, he spoke about the proscription of the federal government's powers by the Constitution. He opened with a Q&A with a twist wherein he asked the questions and he provided the answers. Both were highly predictable.
