The latest figures for Palm Beach County came out today and it wasn't pleasant. According to the Florida Agency for Workforce Innovation, 12.5% of eligible residents were unemployed. This is above record-breaking 12.2% (1.26 million residents) for the entire state.

According to the Unemployment Insurance Tracker website Florida is down to its last \$138 million and is currently borrowing nearly \$1.5B to make good on its promises to pay the unemployed until they find work.

Palm Beach County, as well as other parts of the state, has seen a rise in people starting their own businesses as more residents are unable to find employment.

The Florida legislature has focused on ideas that are ineffective and many legislators have stated it is their duty find jobs for the unemployed. A libertarian perspective may be to have the legislators get out of the way of their constituents so they are able to become employed or start their own businesses without the 'red tape' and delay often caused by government bureaucracy.

On the national level, the Obama administration continues forward with its Big Government ideology to "help" the economy recover from the recession. 
